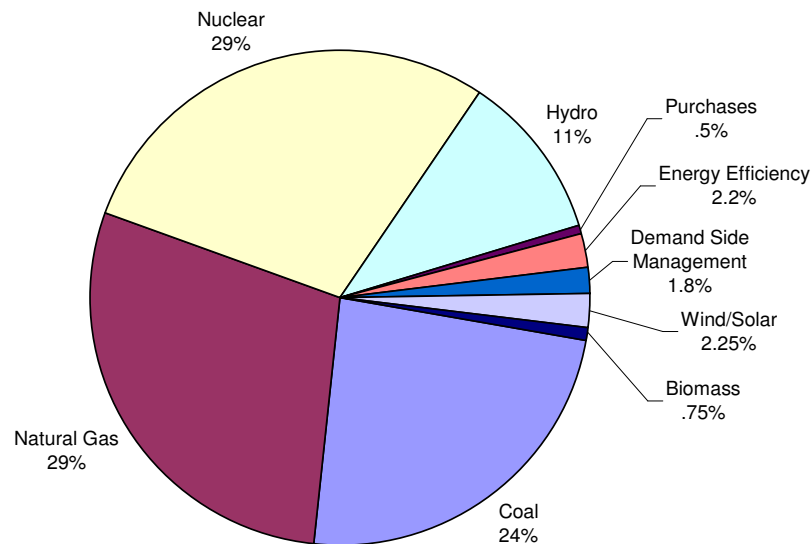

Duke Energy Progress' Plan is a Disaster for the Climate and for Consumers

We demand that Duke Energy Progress, the largest electricity corporation in the United States, shift away from fossil fuels. This action could be the global game-changer humanity needs to avert runaway climate catastrophe.

Duke plans to burn 75% as much coal in 2032 as it will in 2013, and to greatly increase its use of natural gas. In 2032 Duke Energy Carolinas plans to deploy solar and wind power equivalent to only 2.25% of its generating capacity. Energy-saving programs will represent a mere 2.2% of capacity.

NC WARN and allies are working together to change Duke Energy Progress' business model of building unneeded, expensive power plants and repeatedly raising our electricity rates.
